



Come Knit with Me Twisted Rib Slouchy Hat

A beginner hat with a twist. The decorative ribbing and slouchy shape come together to show off the beauty of hand painted colours found in yarns such as Dyeabolicals Super Wash Merino.

Knitting doesn't have to be complicated to be stunning. Be sure to check out my *Come Knit With Me* vlog series for tips and tricks to transform your finished projects from homemade to handmade.

Materials

Sizes : XXS (XS, S, M, L), to fit 16 (18, 20, 22, 24)" / 41 (46, 51, 56, 61) cm head circumference. Sizing allows for 1.5 to 2" negative ease.

Finished Measurements : 14.5 (16, 18.5, 20, 21.5)" / 37 (41, 47, 51, 55) cm

Yarn : Dyeabolical Yarns Superwash Merino 110 (120, 138, 148, 158) yds / 101 (110, 126, 135, 145) m, or similar worsted weight yarn that achieves gauge. Sample knit in *Rava*.

Needle Size : US size 8 / 5 mm 16" (40cm) circular needle, or size to achieve gauge, and same-sized needles for your preferred method of small circumference knitting; US size 7 / 4.5mm 16" (40cm) circular needle for ribbing.

Notions : Stitch marker, tapestry needle

Gauge : 18 sts = 4" / 10cm in Stockinette Stitch on larger needles.

Skill Level : Adventurous Beginner

Abbreviations

CO- cast on

k- knit

k2tog- knit 2 sts together

p- purl

st/s- stitch/es

rnd- round

RT- skip first st on left needle. Knit into second st on left needle, without removing st from left needle. Knit into first st on left needle, and slip both stitches.

Written Instructions

Ribbing

Using smaller circular needles, CO 66 (72, 84, 90, 96) sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: *K2, p1* to end.

Rnd 2: *RT, p1* to end.

Rnd 3: *K2, p1* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-3 until ribbing measures 1.25 (1.5, 1.75, 2, 2.5)" / 3 (4, 4.5, 5, 6.5) cm, or desired length.

Body

Change to larger needle. Knit all rnds until hat measures 7(8, 9, 10, 11)" / 18 (20.5, 23, 25.5, 28) cm from CO edge.

Crown Decreases

Rnd 1: *K1, k2tog* to end. —44 (48, 56, 60, 64) sts

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: *K2tog* to end. —22 (24, 28, 30, 32) sts

Rnd 4: *K2tog* to end. —11 (12, 14, 15, 16) sts

Cut yarn, leaving a 10" tail. Pull tail through remaining sts and secure. Weave in ends. Block and wear!
